Framed as a domestic noir mystery, *Mrs. Christie* explores the Christies' marriage from their introduction, through their courtship, and to Archie's request for divorce that precipitates Agatha's disappearance.

Chicky Diaz is everyone's favorite doorman at the Bohemia, the most famous apartment house in the world, home of celebrities, financiers, and New York's cultural elite. As Chicky changes into his uniform for tonight's shift, he finds himself breaking a cardinal rule of the job: tonight, he'll be carrying a gun, bought only hours earlier, but before he knew of the pandemonium taking over the city. Chicky knows that there's more going on in his patch of sidewalk in front of the Bohemia than anyone's aware of.

On a warm midsummer's night at Babbington Hall, a senior residential home, the peace is shattered by tragedy. Arthur Potts, a beloved resident, dies suddenly, his fall witnessed only by one. The event leaves the community reeling, especially Florence "Florrie" Butterfield, an eighty-seven-year-old resident who missed the incident but is haunted by its details. Renata Green, the home's enigmatic manager, is wracked with guilt over Arthur's death. Florrie resolves to comfort her, setting in motion a chain of revelations and reckonings that will transform the lives of everyone at Babbington.
