Set in 1906 San Francisco, this work of historical fiction follows a soprano and an embroideress, Gemma and Suling, whose lives intertwine through a wealthy magnate, Henry Thornton. When a devastating earthquake hits and the fabled Phoenix Crown disappears, the two women unite to expose a web of secrets and seek justice.

MYSTERY

A Incomplete Revenge by Jacqueline Winspear

Maisie Dobbs, the extraordinary Psychologist and Investigator, delves into a strange series of crimes in a small rural community. She accepts an apparently straightforward assignment from an old friend to investigate certain matters concerning a potential land purchase. Her inquiries take her to a picturesque village in Kent, but beneath its pastoral surface she finds evidence that something is amiss.

Between Two Kingdoms by Suleika Jaouad

When Suleika Jaouad graduated from Princeton in 2010, she was considering a career as a war correspondent. Instead, within months, at 22, she was diagnosed with a rare form of acute myeloid leukemia. She quickly found herself fighting for her life in New York City cancer wards, where she was given a 35 percent chance of survival. This book is a searching memoir of her illness and its aftermath and figuring out how to live again.
