FICTION

Bound for Gold by Willaim Martin

Rare-book dealer Peter Fallon returns in an historical novel about the California Gold Rush. There's a search for a journal from the Gold Rush. The stolen journal follows young James Spencer, of the Sagamore Mining Company, on a spectacular journey from staid Boston, up the Sacramento River to the Mother Lode. In the present, Peter Fallon's son asks his father for help appraising the rare books in the Spencer estate and that includes reconstructing Spencer's seven-part journal, through action-filled search for a "lost river of gold"

MYSTERY

Judge Stone by James Patterson

In this courtroom drama, Judge Mary Stone, a black circuit judge in rural Alabama, and the most respected citizen in town, must oversee the trial of a doctor accused of illegally performing an abortion on a thirteen-year-old. No judge can satisfy everyone. It would be dangerous to try. But Judge Stone is willing to fight to bring justice to the people and place she loves.

Zero Days by Ruth Ware

Jack uses her expert hacking and physical security skills to evade police and uncover a conspiracy involving a cybersecurity threat that her husband was killed to cover up.

NON-FICTION

The Warhead by Jeffrey Stern

Tells the story of "Paveway", the first "smart bomb", through the lives of seven interconnected stories. They're stories of Nazis, Kennedys, Operation Paperclip, and Walt Disney; of the Apollo mission and the space shuttle Challenger disaster.
