Fathers and Sons by Ivan Tugenev

This classic Russian novel is set in 1862, it examines the conflict between traditional, moderate "fathers" and the radical, nihilistic younger generation ("sons") in the 1860s. The story follows Bazarov, a nihilist who rejects authority, and his friend Arkady, as they visit their traditionalist families, bringing ideological tension and romantic complications to their peaceful estates.

Federal investigator Dan Pardee, Brandon Walker's son-in-law, crosses paths with Sheriff Joanna Brady as he traces the bloody path of a merciless serial killer across the Southwest in this intense thriller.

Dark of Night by Suzanne Brockmann

Only a handful of people in the world know that James Nash is alive. For years, Nash performed ultra-covert "Black Ops" missions for a shadowy government agency. But when he walked away from their dirty work, his ruthless bosses weren't about to let him go. After their attempt to assassinate him nearly succeeds, his former partner Lawrence Decker, with the FBI's help, fakes Nash's death to protect him.
