***Skeltons at the Feast*** by Chris Bohjalian

*Skeltons at the Feast* is a 2008 historical novel inspired by a real WWII diary. It's set during the final months of World War II, following a group of German refugees fleeing the advancing Soviet army, including Prussian aristocrat Anna Emmerich, her family, and a Scottish POW she loves, Callum. Their perilous journey west is complicated by the presence of a Jewish man, Uri Singer, who is disguised as a Wehrmacht corporal named Manfred, creating a tense love triangle and exploring themes of survival, love, and the human cost of war.
