Before Sunrise

Before Sunrise begins with a chance encounter aboard a train. Two young travelers decide to spend an evening wandering through Vienna together. Their conversations—curious, playful, and reflective—gradually reveal what

each is searching for. Linklater shapes the film around everyday observation, giving their connection a natural, unforced rhythm. The city becomes a quiet backdrop to the intimacy that emerges, more sensed than explained. They part the next day. Linklater returned to these characters with the same actors, Ethan Hawke and Julie Delpy, in 2004 and 2013, creating a trilogy that traces their lives nearly two decades after their separation. This first part asks the question: Can the greatest romance of your life last only one night?

The Apartment is a bittersweet romantic dramedy that blends sharp corporate satire with genuine emotional warmth. The film follows Bud Baxter, an ambitious but lonely worker in a huge New York insurance company. He lends out his apartment to the executives as a place to take their mistresses. As Baxter becomes entangled in the personal fallout of these arrangements, he begins to confront the moral compromises behind his professional ambitions. One night he's left with a major problem to solve. At the center of the story is his connection with Fran Kubelik, a kind but troubled elevator operator whose own vulnerabilities mirror his. Wilder balances humor and melancholy with remarkable precision, creating a portrait of midcentury office life that is both funny and quietly devastating.
