When Gelsomina, a naïve young woman, is purchased from her impoverished mother by circus strongman Zampanò to be his wife and partner, she loyally endures her husband's coldness and abuse as they travel the Italian countryside performing together. Soon Zampanò must deal with his jealousy and conflicted feelings about Gelsomina. The film's emotional power comes from the contrast between innocence and cruelty, and from the quiet moments

where characters reveal more than they intend. It is one of Fellini's most moving explorations of the human spirit. (115 minutes, English subtitles)
